 - b. How does this command impact your understanding of evangelism? In what ways is it challenging? In what ways is it comforting?
4. God has called us to be his witnesses in the world.
 - a. What does it mean to be a witness for God?
 - b. In what ways are we tempted to be more than or less than a witness?
5. As the Church, it is all our responsibility to seek after the “one more”.
 - a. How do we balance this process of growing in our own faith while seeking to help others grow as well?
 - b. Do these processes work together or against each other? How so?
6. Share with the group who your “one more” could be.
 - a. If you have struggled to invite them to church, how might you change your tactic moving forward?
