Ice Breakers (5-10 minutes)

Sermon Study

Read Psalm 8

1. What does it mean to you that God created everything for you? Is this easy or hard for you to believe?
2. God gave man dominion over creation (plants, animals, land, etc.) – a great privilege, but also a great responsibility. How do we live out this responsibility as Christians?
3. What role does science/proof play in guiding your belief in God and his work in creation?
4. What was the most compelling piece of evidence for you from Pastor's sermon?
5. How can we go about sharing this information? How can we convince people when the voices of science and reason seem to speak so loudly against creation?
6. It seems like science and faith ultimately end up at the same spot – we can't fully comprehend how this all came to be – it comes down to faith! What are the major differences between the believer and the non-believer at this point in the conversation?

“Digging Deeper”

Read Revelation 21: 1-5 & Isaiah 65: 17-25. God says that He will create a “new heaven and a new earth”. Discuss what this means to you. What do you think this new creation will be like?
