Sermon Questions

April 12 – 1 Timothy 1:3-7 – “Sound Doctrine”

- 1) If we are believing something that is wrong, we should want to know the truth.
 - a) What holds you back from accepting or seeking truth?
- 2) If others are believing something that is wrong, we should seek ways to correct their error.
 - a) What holds you back from sharing truth and correcting others' misguided beliefs?
 - b) Try to describe an effective and God-honoring way for correcting others.
- 3) Were there any discussion points/truth statements from the sermon that raised questions or concerns for you?

April 19 – 1 Timothy 1:12-17 – “Chief of Sinners”

- 4) The Law of God plays some important roles in our life and the lives of others.
 - a) Describe these roles.
 - b) Do you agree that the Law is good? Why or Why Not?
- 5) Paul identifies himself as the “foremost of sinners”.
 - a) What do you think allowed him to be so open and transparent about some painful aspects of his past? What might prevent us from being this open or transparent?
 - b) How did God use Paul's history to serve the Gospel? How does he use your history?
- 6) God's patience with sinners often means pain for us or for others because of sinful choices.
 - a) How do you feel about this reality?
- 7) “Being a good person does not get us into heaven”.
 - a) Explain why this is true. (see *Romans 3:10-12, 22-24*)
 - b) Why do you think so many people tend to believe this false statement?
