Ice Breaker Questions

- 1. What is the first thing you would do if you were on a trip to Rome?
- 2. What is something new you have recently learned?

Sermon Questions

- 1. In Romans chapter 6 (verses 1-14), Paul talks about the newness of life that comes with Baptism. What new insights did you gain regarding Baptism during last week's message?
- 2. In Romans chapter 6 (verse 5) we are told that if we have died with Christ, then we will also be raised with Him. What does this news of a future resurrection mean to you? How does it impact your daily life now?
- 3. In Romans chapters 6 & 7, we hear about the "freedom" that we have from sin and from law. What does this freedom mean to you? How are Christians to use their freedom in this life? (see especially Romans 6:12-14, 17-18)
- 4. In what ways is the "Law" good for us? In what ways is the "Law" bad for us?
- 5. Satan seeks to twist and manipulate the good things that God gives us, how have you seen evidence of this in your own life and the lives of others?
- 6. In what ways do you relate to the struggle Paul describes in Romans 7:15-24? How does this description impact your perception/ideas of the "Christian life"? What steps might you take to start engaging this battle more consistently?

"Digging Deeper"

1. Review Romans 6:20-23, 7:4-6. What 2 types of fruit are described? How do we go about producing the right type of fruit? (see also John 15:1-11). What will that fruit look like? (see also Galatians 5: 19-23).
