Sunday, March 8 – Leading our Families – John 19:25-27

2. There were 3 major points discussed regarding our care of others. Which one stands out the most to you? Which one do you need to work on and why?
 - a. “Don’t Be So Busy that you miss seeing the needs”
 - b. “Become 2nd”
 - c. “Build A Legacy of Faith for Eternity”

Sunday, March 15 – Serving the “Least of These” – John 19:28-29

3. How we care for the “least of these” will be a mark that defines our walk as Christians. Why is this so important?
4. There are many significant needs throughout the world discussed, which was most surprising to you? How aware were you of the needs that exist?
5. We tend to blame God for the misery that we see around us.
 - a. How has your perspective changed in this area?
 - b. What factors prevent you from trying to help alleviate the suffering of others?

Digging Deeper

Read Matthew 25:31-40; John 10:25-30

1. What characteristics mark us as Jesus’ sheep?
2. In Matthew 25, “those on His right” are surprised to hear of the good works they did (see Matthew 25:37-39). Why is this significant? What does this teach us about our good works?
3. See James 2:14-17 & Ephesians 2:8-10. Are we saved by our Faith or by our works?
