Ice Breaker Idea: Share about a TV show that you have enjoyed watching lately.

Questions:

- 1. Do you agree that "Do Not Judge" seems to be the most popular verse to quote among those who are outside of the church? Why is this such a popular phrase?
- 2. In this passage, Jesus commands us not to judge. What is His definition of judging as we discussed in the sermon? How did this change your perspective?
- 3. There are 2 errors we often fall into judging others excessively or completely avoiding it at all costs. What are the motivations behind these 2 tendencies? What does a healthy balance or middle ground look like?
- 4. It is easy to see small defects in others while missing large defects in ourselves (see Matthew 7:3). Why is does this happen? What will help us to reverse this in our lives?
- 5. "If we truly love those around us, we will want them to pass the test too". What prevents us from proclaiming the truth that there is a test, and that Jesus is the only answer?
- 6. What areas do you see as the most difficult to speak truth into in your lives and in the lives of those around you?
