Sermon Questions – “Serve All”

1. What is one concept or quote that really stood out to you from the sermon?
2. When we serve, it should be done so humbly. What does humble service look like? What beliefs, emotions, thoughts, etc. prevent us from serving in this way?
3. “How do you act when you are the most powerful person in the room?” Why is this an important question to answer? What do we learn from observing ourselves and others in these situations?
4. When we serve, we should do so without expecting anything in return. Have you ever truly done this? Describe such a time. On the other hand, describe a time when your expectation of getting something in return hurt a relationship or situation.
5. When we serve, we should serve all people equally. How did Jesus demonstrate this in our text from John 13 and elsewhere during His ministry? How far are you willing to take this? What excuses might we be tempted to make?
6. How is serving in the ways described a blessing in and of itself?

Read Luke 14:7-11

2. How would you summarize and explain the teaching of Jesus from this passage? Have you ever seen this play out in your own life?
